Any qualifying out-of-pocket expenses must be approved by TRHC and be accompanied by paid receipts for reimbursement to occur.

TRHC may request additional information from you, or an interview, when considering your request. If you receive a grant, TRHC will determine the terms of the grant payment and accompanying documentation required to fulfill the grant expectations and award. If you receive an award, TRHC requires you to provide a photo along with consent for media publication. You may also be asked to volunteer at a TRHC event.

Grant applicants and awardees enrolled in a long-term career program may re-apply during future grant cycles for additional consideration. Award notification will occur in July of each year.
